Owner's Comments: Waterford is a 1996 Class I Elite Hanoverian stallion imported from the State Stud at Celle. He offers some of the best modern breeding. His sire, Wolkenstein II, is by the world-renown Weltmeyer, and his dam, Minna, is by the modern refining stallion Matcho x. Minna's dam is by the famous dressage sire Pik König. Waterford was Champion of the 1998 Stallion Licensing and his terrific movement, temperament and rideability contributed to his winning the Stallion Performance Test at Adelheidsdorf in 1999 with very high scores. He has more than 400 foals in Europe, including licensed sons and Verden auction horses as well as successful offspring in North America. In 2006, Waterford was ranked sixth in the world of all warmblood stallions by the German National Federation with a dressage index of 163. In his first show season in 2007, Waterford won 18 of 22 classes at Third and Fourth Level and was the USDF Hanoverian All-Breeds Third Level Adult Amateur Champion and USDF Region 7 High Score at Third Level. He was also Champion Stallion both times he was shown in USDF breed shows and California Dressage Society Champion Stallion in-hand. Waterford consistently passes on his temperament and rideability, elastic, powerful movement and elegant, correct conformation. He has youngsters competing very successfully in-hand and under saddle, including championships in sporthorse and dressage.
