Dear Prospective Buyer:

Thank you for your interest in our Buckeye Bonanza sale horses this year! The purpose of this letter is to inform our prospective buyers of the following information on each horse:

- Any performance or pedigree highlights.
- Any known physical or behavioral problems.
- Our opinion of what uses, disciplines, or sports for which each horse might be well-suited.
- Our opinion of what experience level owner or rider each horse needs at this time.

Please be aware that although every effort has been made to completely disclose any known factors that might be considered negative, there is *no guarantee that an oversight will not occur*. Should an oversight occur, The Ohio State University and its agents cannot be held responsible.

Roosters Gold Whiz (Zeppelin) was foaled at The Ohio State University Equine Facility in February 2019. He is sired by GR Crome Berry Whiz, an AQHA point earner and NRHA money earner with lifetime earnings in excess of \$28,000. Zeppelin's paternal grandsire, Topsail Whiz has won over \$72,000 and his offspring have earned more than 12 million dollars. Zeppelin's dam, Peeking For Gold, is out of a daughter of Mark Lady High, a mare that has produced several NRHA Futurity and Derby champions.

Zeppelin has been handled by our students consistently since birth and has no behavioral problems of which I am aware. He presented with hind leg lameness in 2020 and radiographs indicated degenerative arthritis in his hocks. His hocks were re-evaluated this spring (March 2021) as a precaution prior to starting him under saddle and radiographs indicated that both hocks were progressing towards fusion. He was started under saddle this semester in the Advanced Equine Behavior & Training class with student trainer Maddy Diehl and has not presented with any concerns. However, it is likely that he will need maintenance in the future. A copy of his health records, radiographs, letter from the attending veterinarian, and training journals are included in his sale portfolio.

Zeppelin has been ridden in the arena, around the farm, and hauled to Mohican State Park and Lobdell Reserve for trail riding. He is a responsive gelding that maneuvers obstacles with ease. With continued training, he could do well in a variety of ranch horse classes or out on the trail. Due to his limited experience under saddle, he is suitable for an intermediate or experienced rider at this time.

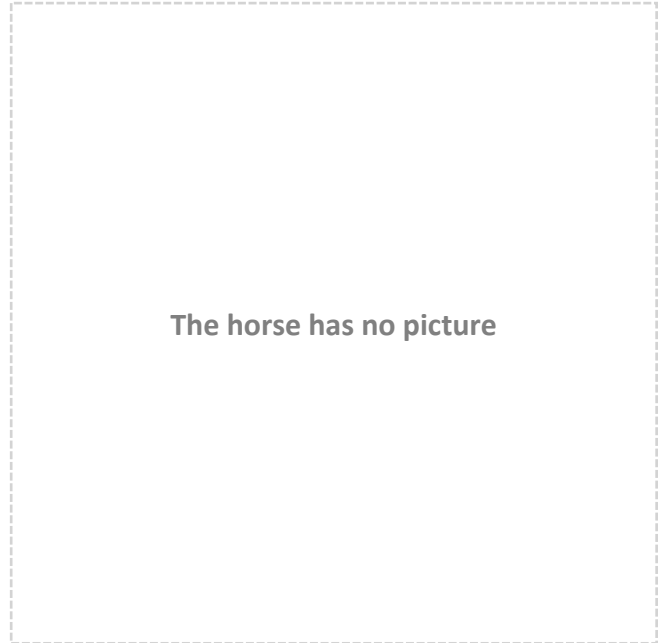

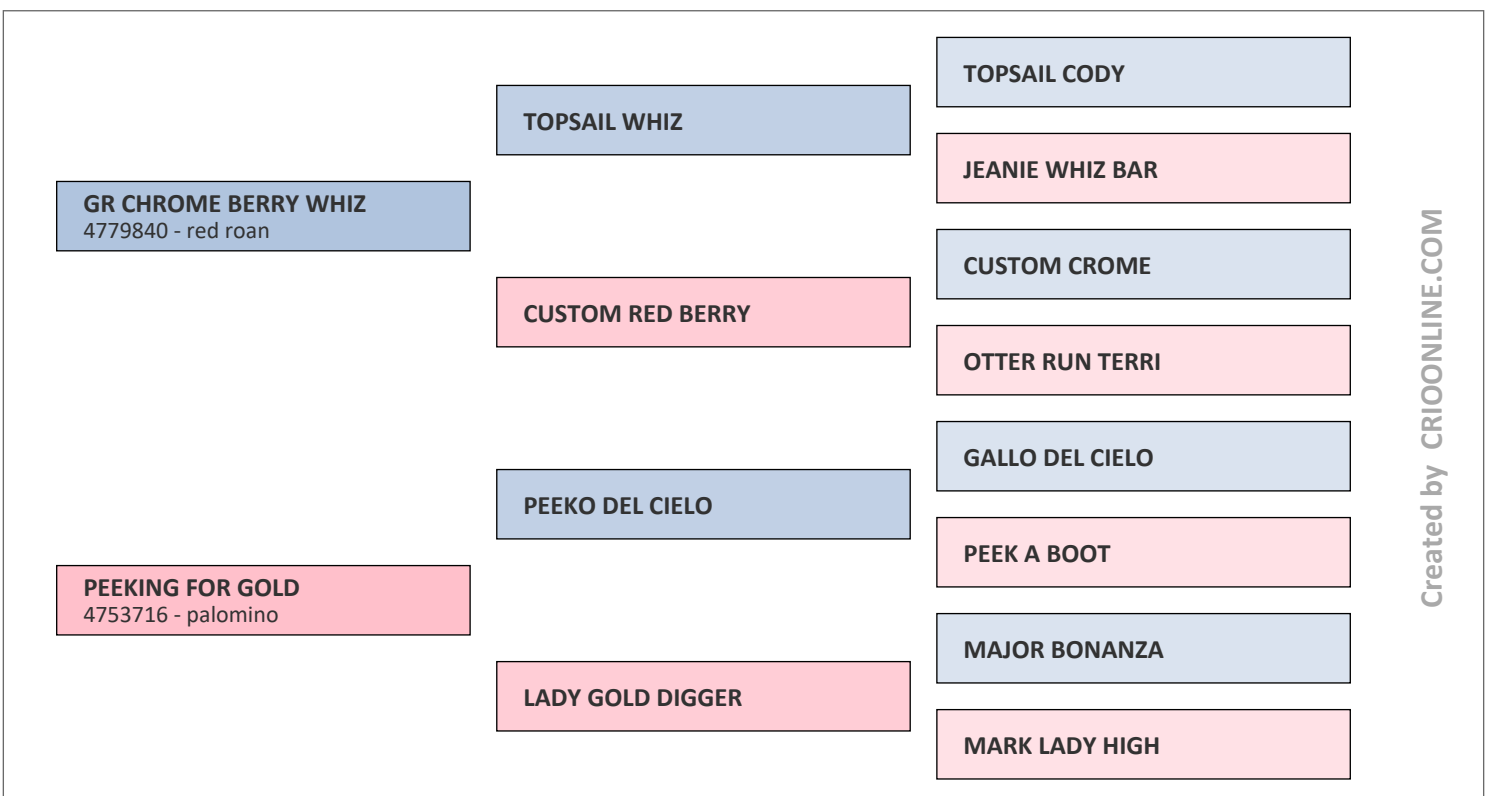

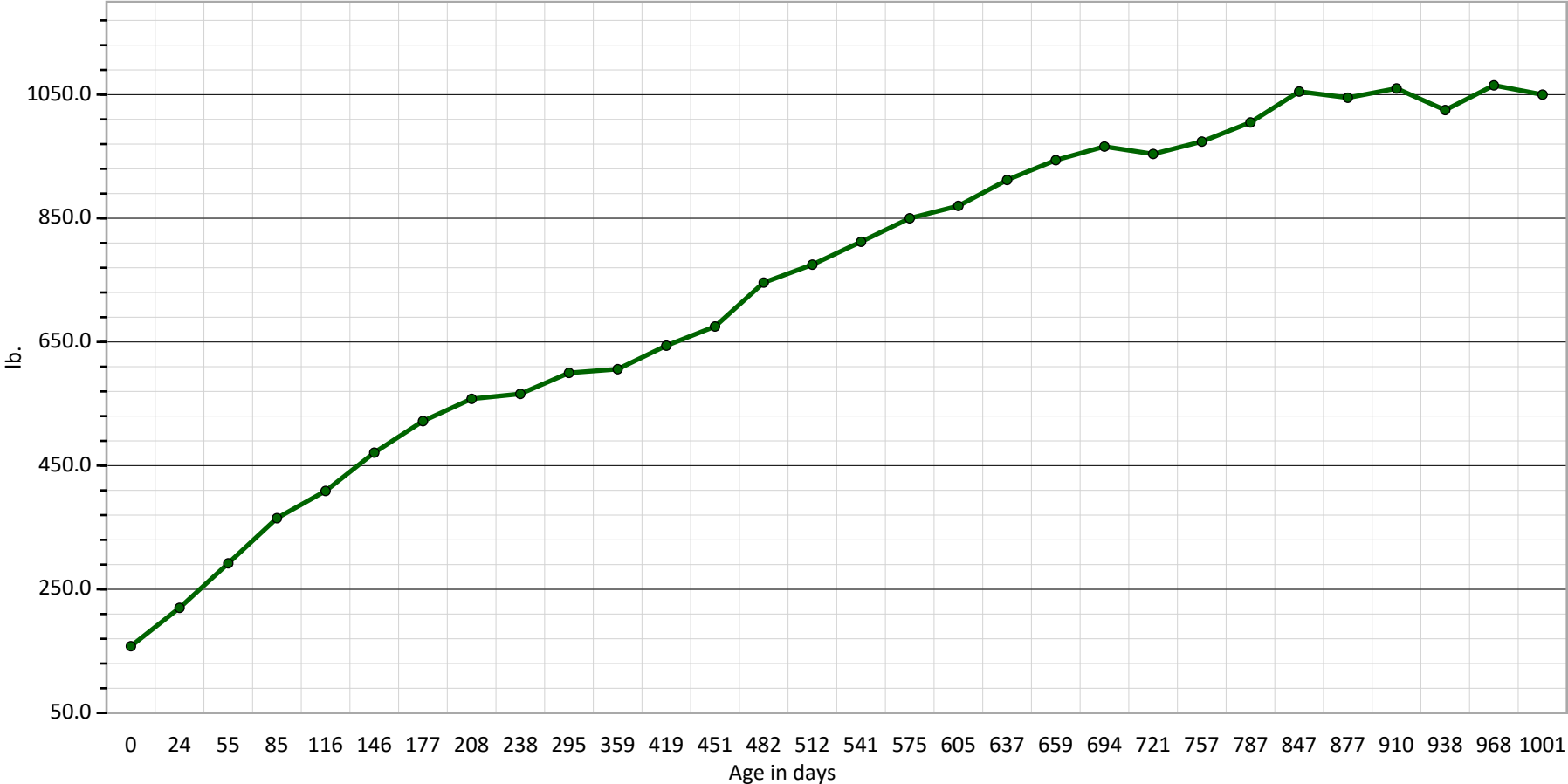

To Who it May Concern:

This letter is in reference to “Zeppelin” a 2 year old gelding owned by the Ohio State University College of Ag. I examined “Zeppelin” in March of 2020 for a lameness of the rear. Flexion tests of the both rear limbs revealed a positive response. Radiographs of the hocks revealed severe changes of the distal intertarsal joint consistent with degenerative arthritis. Because of his age and radiographic changes, along with the response to lameness exam it is evident he will need some kind of maintenance to allow him to be sound for work.
