Thank you for your interest in our Buckeye Bonanza sale horses this year! The purpose of this letter is to inform our prospective buyers of the following information on each horse:

- Any performance or pedigree highlights.
- Any known physical or behavioral problems.
- Our opinion of what uses, disciplines, or sports for which each horse might be well-suited.
- Our opinion of what experience level owner or rider each horse needs at this time.

Please be aware that although every effort has been made to completely disclose any known factors that might be considered negative, there is *no guarantee that an oversight will not occur*. Should an oversight occur, The Ohio State University and its agents cannot be held responsible.

Chillychillybangbang (Chili) Kings Urban Legend (Meyer) was foaled at The Ohio State University Equine Facility in February 2019. He is sired by GR Crome Berry Whiz, an AQHA point earner and NRHA money earner with lifetime earnings in excess of \$28,000. Zeppelin's paternal grandsire, Topsail Whiz has won over \$72,000 and his offspring have earned more than 12 million dollars. Chili's dam, Wimpys Little Annie, is a daughter of the NHRA Hall of Fame stallion, Wimpys Little Step, who is also an NRHA Hall of Fame stallion with offspring earning more than 12 million dollars to date.

Chili has been handled by our students consistently since birth and has no behavioral problems of which I am aware. He does have a slight overbite that has not affected the wear pattern of his teeth or his ability to maintain body condition. Chili was started under saddle this semester in the Advanced Equine Behavior & Training class with student trainer Holly Crandall. In September, he presented with stiffness in his right hind leg and radiographs indicated arthritic changes in his hocks. It is likely that he will need maintenance in the future. A copy of his health records, radiographs, letter from the attending veterinarian, and training journals are included in his sale portfolio.

Chili is progressing nicely in his training this semester and he has been ridden in the arena, around the farm, and hauled to Mohican State Park and Lobdell Reserve for trail riding. He is a willing gelding that maneuvers obstacles with ease and stands quietly next to cattle. With continued training, he could do well in a variety of ranch horse classes. Due to his limited experience under saddle, he is suitable for an intermediate rider at this time.

To Who it May Concern:

This letter is in regards the horse named "Chili", a 2 year old gelding, owned by the Ohio State University College of Ag. I evaluated "Chili" on September 15th for a lameness and followed with radiographs of the stifles and hocks due to a positive response to flexion tests of the rear legs. The radiographs revealed changes at the distal intertarsal joint greater on the left than the right but present in both. The changes and the positive response on the exam, coupled with his young age would indicate that he will need some maintenance in the future probably sooner than later.
