The QH gelding "No Exotic Tiger" owned by Lindsay Kern has a small apical chip off the lateral sesamoid of the right hind limb. The fragment is displaced. There is no clinical lameness, no joint effusion, and no response to hyper flexing of this limb.

The apical sesamoid fractures are mostly inconsequential. The horse is not unsound, and I would not anticipate this condition ever causing a lameness
